- You'll no longer receive Office 2016 and Office 2019 software updates from Microsoft Update.
- You'll no longer receive phone or chat technical support.
- No further updates to support content will be provided and most online help content will be retired.

October 14, 2025 for both Office 2016 and Office 2019.

• No More Updates:

Microsoft will not release any further updates, including security patches, for these versions after the end of support date.

• Security Risks:

Future updates to Windows or other Microsoft services might not be compatible with Office 2016 or 2019.
